The process of archiving the documents and evidence associated with a digital transaction in order to comply with inspections, establish proof, and ensure legal admissibility, is subjected to legal requirements.

Indeed, it is imperative that **the entire dematerialization chain leading to archiving be secure** so the requirements imposed by legislation are met and the legal security of archives is guaranteed.

Archiving and preserving evidence is a legal obligation

- One must be able to
- prove the authenticity and integrity of the documents;
 - demonstrate the security of the deployed processes by means of traceability tools and event logging;
 - guarantee that confidentiality is protected, especially with regard to the GDPR; and
 - meet accessibility and availability needs.


